Terry Brase made a motion to approve the agenda and Micah Cutler 2nd the motion. All members present voted aye.

There were no minutes to approve.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- 1. <u>Conference Committee</u> Brad Cutler reported that the conference was going well. There were 200+ attendees and more vendors present than at the 2003 Conference. The conference would turn a profit.
- 2. <u>Finance Committee</u> Terry Brase gave a report of current financial standings. See attached report.
- 3. <u>Education Committee</u> Herb Kuehne reported that he is making contacts with colleges and universities in Iowa and gathering information about course offerings. IGIC is covering the cost of duplicating ArcView for distribution to those schools involved in the GIS site license.
- 4. <u>Strategic Planning & Bylaws</u> Brad Cutler had no report but stated that the committee would be meeting before the next quarterly meeting.

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5. Special Committees

Metadata Workshops – Patrick Brown held three metadata workshops in Cedar Falls, Ames, and Council Bluffs. Over 30 people participated and he was offering an additional workshop at the IGIC conference.

Historic Aerial Photography – Katheryn Clark (DNR) and Robin McNeely (ISU) have scanned and rectified 1930s era aerial photography for 10 areas in Iowa. They hope to do more areas and decades depending on funding and support.

- 6. <u>Remote Sensing</u> Jim Giglierano reported that 20+ people attended a one-day workshop on Satellite Remote Sensing to GIS in Cedar Falls.
- <u>Website</u> Patrick Brown reported that the IGIC website will be migrating to Plone, version 2 in the near future. He continues to welcome suggestions and input into the website. It got quite a bit of use for the 2005 IGIC conference planning.

USER GROUPS/LIAISON REPORTS

Eastern Iowa Users Group – Eastern Iowa GIS Day will be celebrated on Thursday, October 27, 2005 at Hawkeye Community College.

<u>Iowa Counties Information Technology (ICIT)</u> – ICIT had their mid-year conference in June 2005 with 120+ attendees. Micah Cutler (ICIT President) would like to see a joint conference in 2007 with IGIC and ICIT. She felt that there would be resistance from the ICIT organization and would discuss it with them. Members present felt that a joint GIS/IT conference would be mutually beneficial.

<u>MAGIC</u> – There were several Iowa attendees at a LiDAR workshop sponsored by MAGIC in Sioux Falls, SD. The group learned about LiDAR applications and opportunities and spurred discussion about a possible statewide LiDAR flight. Prices have dropped substantially and make such an endeavor within the realm of possibility.

STATEWIDE COORDINATOR UPDATE

As of June 30, 2005, Alan Jensen is no longer the Iowa State GIS Coordinator. ISU Extension offices no longer were funding such a position. Alan summed up the activities in the past year and thanked everyone for the opportunity to be in the position these last several years. Brad Cutler discussed that IGIC would have to brainstorm about funding possibilities for a future state GIS coordinator and this would likely be a part of the strategic planning committee.

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

Positions up for election and vote were: Vice Chair – Herb Kuehne Treasurer – Terry Brase Secretary – Micah Cutler Past Chair – Kristen Tuttle

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Ben McConville made a motion to approve the candidates and it was seconded by Chad Olson. All members present voted aye.

NSGIC CONFERNCE

MAGIC offered a travel grant for a representative from Iowa to attend the NSGIC Conference in Rochester, NY. Since Alan Jensen was unavailable, it was determined that Brad Cutler would attend as Iowa's and IGIC's representative. The conference was from September 25 -29, 2005, and Brad would have a full report at the next quarterly meeting.

FUTURE IGIC CONFERENCES

The locations of the next two biennial conferences have been set. The 2007 conference will be in Sioux City, Iowa and the 2009 conference will be in Waterloo, Iowa. Both conferences will be in the spring, opposite the MAGIC conference. Micah Cutler made a motion to approve the locations and it was seconded by Herb Kuehne. There was one dissenting vote by Kristen Tuttle, who felt the locations were too remote. All IGIC members interested in planning the next conference should talk to Ron Koch.
